Cohort I:

Ambulatory anesthesiologists who wish to work in a hospital setting



Cohort II:

Anesthesiologists who have been away from medicine and wish to return



Cohort III:

Anesthesiologists only able to work in a structured environment per the DOH/OPMC



Cohort IV:

Practicing anesthesiologists who are working in a hospital but have lost their board eligibility and consequentially need to spend time going through that process

Enrollees participate in problem-based learning discussions, didactic lectures, and hands-on patient care throughout this program.
